Summer Professional Development Residency

Call for Applications

The **Centre for Craft and Design** is now accepting applications for our **Summer Residency** in the Ceramics, Wood, Glass, Metal and Weaving/Textile Studios.

The Residency is designed to suit emerging, pre-professional and self-directed artists who need time and space to develop a body of work while exploring individual style and technique. The Residency is open to advanced students and recent graduates looking for their next opportunity and guidance into the art world.

Residents will have access to the studios 24 hours a day from June 22 - August 31. In addition to a mandatory orientation, there are 3 mandatory meetings as a group throughout the summer. First an artist talk, a mid way check in, and an exhibition meeting.

As a group the residents will have an exhibition of their works created at the Centre during the Residency to be held in the Mary E. Black Gallery, September 1 - 17, 2017 with an opening on August 31 at 6:00.

The cost of the residency is \$325 (plus HST) plus a \$50 damage deposit (cash) to be returned upon the completion of the residency, return of key, and clean, undamaged studios.

Applicants must be able to work independently, conduct themselves in a professional manner and be comfortable working in a cooperative studio environment. Residents will be expected to keep their spaces and the studio tidy; as well as treat the facilities and equipment respectfully.
